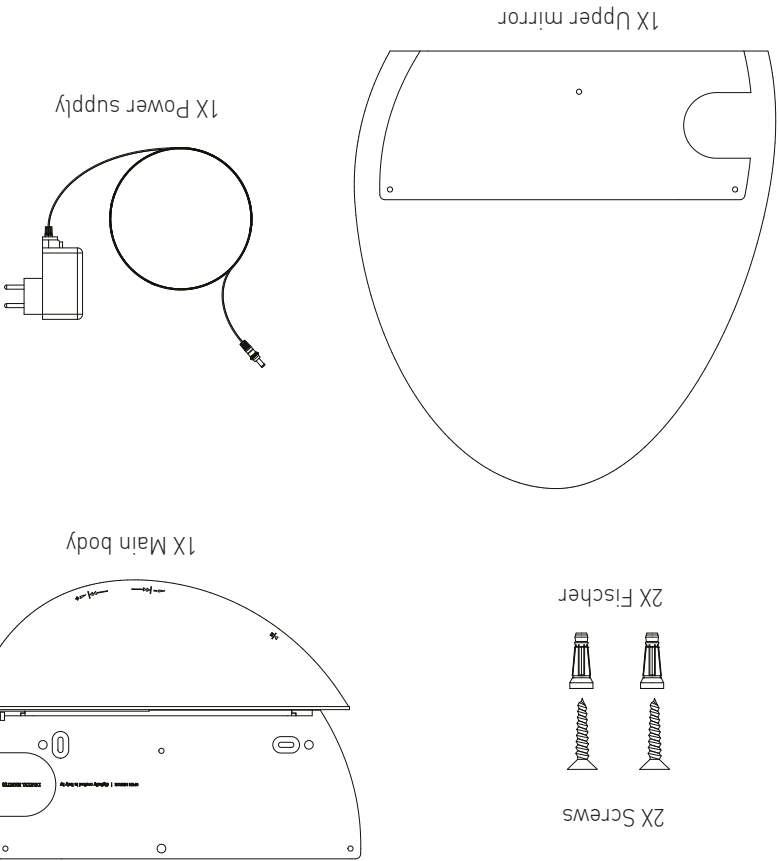

### COMPATIBILITY

The **OPEN MIRROR** is compatible with all iPhone and most iPod models. For iPhone 5 with Lightning connector, it's necessary a Lightning to 30-pin Adapter.

Not compatible with 3rd generation with dock connector (iPod has four buttons above the touch wheel).

### WARNINGS and CAUTIONS

### TROUBLESHOOTING

iPod or iPhone does not dock properly or will not charge:

- Check for obstructions in dock connectors and reseat device.
- Remove your iPod or iPhone case.

No sound:

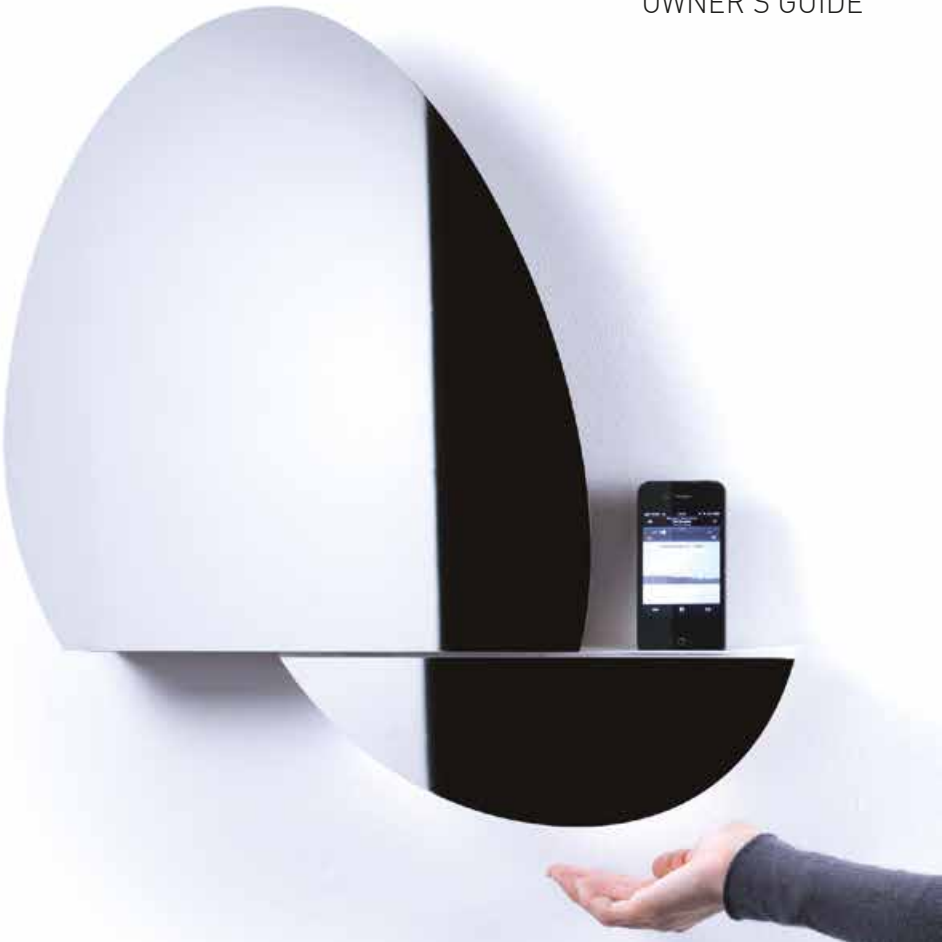
- Make sure system has AC power.
- Turn system volume up and ensure source is playing.
- Remove iPod or iPhone from dock for 5 seconds, then firmly reseat it.
- Unplug power cord for 1 minute, then plug back in. This resets the system.

1

- Drill 2 holes separated by 22cm (horizontal). Use a 6 mm drill.
- Fix the OPEN MIRROR to the wall with the 2 screws provided.

2

- Slide the lower part of the Main Body and route the cable behind.
- Verify that the mirror is **OFF**.
- Plug the power source.

3

- Unbox the Upper Mirror
- Place the Upper Mirror **inserting** the upper 3 pins into the Main Body holes.

4

- Turn **ON** the OPEN MIRROR

(The Gap in the middle will **light up** once you turn it on)

5

- Slide & Connect your iPod / iPhone.

**Play** your favorite music, raise the volume and Enjoy!

USING THE OPEN MIRROR

PLAY | PAUSE

Place and Remove your hand under **Sensor A**

BACKWARD

Swap your hand between **Sensors C & B**

SKIP SONG

VOLUME

VOLUME DOWN  
Place and hold your hand under **Sensor B**

VOLUME UP  
Place and hold your hand under **Sensor C**

FORWARD

Swap your hand between **Sensors B & C**
